



The Cary Woman's Club is actively involved in volunteer service and the support of community organizations. The Club's mission **"the object of the Club shall be to promote the civic, cultural, social and educational advancement of Cary, and to provide service to our community."** The Grants/Community Projects Program provides direct financial contributions to organizations/individuals in the Cary community for specific projects and initiatives. Areas of interest should include the Arts, Conservation, Education, Home Life, International Outreach or Public Issues.

Applications will be reviewed by the Grants/Community Projects Program Committee as follows for community service projects; August, October and February. Applications received by August 4 will be awarded at the end of September. Applications received by October 1 will be awarded at the end of November. Applications received by February 1 will be awarded at the end of March. Grants applications will be accepted through the year but with a deadline of March 1 and will be awarded by the end of April. A letter will be sent to you from the Cary Woman's Club regarding the status of your request. Within sixty days (60) of receipt of your grant check or sixty days (60) days after the end of your Project, the grantee must submit a 1-page report outlining how the grant/project money contributed to your success. In the case of Club member applicants this can be accomplished through the project reporting form. If applicable, please enclose any publication that was created regarding your project. **Application deadlines can be extended at the discretion of the Committee.**

To be considered for the Grant/Community Service Project Program complete the application. Grant applicants additionally need to provide your organizations' 501(c)3 document with Tax ID number and mail or deliver it to:
