2013-2014

September 2013: Ed Gauf, Director of Downtown Development, spoke to the club about current and future development of Cary.

October 2013: CWC and Jr's hosted District VI Fall Meeting at Christ the King Lutheran Church. We purchased refreshments from Life Experiences.
