## 2025 Guidelines / Requirements for Scholarship Applications

- 1. A completed application. This form may be found and downloaded at **www.carywomansclub.org** under Community Service.
- 2. Applicant must be a senior (male or female) residing in Cary, Apex, or Morrisville and attending a high school in the Wake County Public School System, NC.
- 3. Applicant must plan to attend an accredited **public** four-year college or university in the state of North Carolina.
- 4. Applicant must have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or greater for their junior and first half of senior year **and** provide a copy of an official high school transcript through the first half of senior year, including grade point average (weighted and unweighted), and class rank with number of students in class.
- 5. A copy of applicant's ACT / SAT scores. (Optional)
- 6. A completed copy of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 7. Applicants must be a United States citizen or present proof of permanent resident status.
- 8. A letter of recommendation from a school counselor, principal, teacher, or a business/professional person.
- 9. A short essay stating why the applicant desires to continue their education, what are their future educational plans, and why financial assistance is desired. Applicant may also provide additional information that they would like the scholarship committee to know about them or their family.
- 10. Applicant must be available for an interview with the Scholarship Committee to be scheduled in April 2025.

NOTE: Applications must be received electronically no later than midnight on Monday, March 24, 2025. Email the completed electronic (pdf or word) application to kmfiumara@gmail.com

Scholarship money will be paid directly to the recipient's chosen accredited four-year public North Carolina university, college, or technical school.
